Representation

I have always found it important that each chapter in our district is represented equally and feels included on a district level. Numerous chapters are involved throughout the district, from serving on various committees and attending events, but there are still chapters that have not been involved within the Southwest District in some time. If we allow chapters to go unnoticed like this, it is easy for them to fall by the wayside and go inactive. This has happened to some of Zeta Beta's little brother chapters; keeping all of our chapters highlighted and involved on a district level will be able to prevent the worst from happening. In order to fulfill this goal, I will:

- Work alongside my fellow district officers to ensure every chapter is reached. Through checking on each chapter, we can see if they need assistance or guidance in things such as paperwork, or just general advice on a chapter-basis. We can also encourage big brother chapters to reach out to their little brother chapters to ensure they are continuing to strive for the highest.
- Encourage chapters to partake in the Southwest District Instagram and Facebook, whether it be in the form of commenting, sharing posts, or hosting Instagram takeovers. I also plan to involve more brothers in the Southwest District Discord server.
- Highlight chapters on our social media feed (in addition to the New ALTO) to see more
 of what our chapters do so we are able to share traditions and history with one another.
 Each of our chapters do numerous things that support and uplift each of our four pillars,
 or celebrate one of our Kappa Kappa Psi national months. Our social media platforms are
 an excellent place to showcase our amazing chapters that might not make the feature page
 on the New ALTO. This could become possible by mentioning the Southwest District
 social media account on individual chapter's posts or stories, or submitting pictures and
 descriptions of each event for the Southwest District to post on the social media
 platforms.

History

The Member at Large also serves as the District Historian; as the Zeta Beta Historian, I have a passion for capturing events pictorially and through writing. My own chapter's traditions and history have become unclear, so my chapter goal has been to find out origins of our traditions and inform current brothers of our history. It would be an honor to do this not only for my chapter, but for the district as well. I will seek out opportunities to preserve our history and traditions by the following:

- Conduct research of each of our district traditions to discover their origins and how they have developed to what they are now known as. I also plan to publicize this information on the social media and discord server so that more brothers are enlightened by our rich history as a fraternity. This would also help them with knowing what each award or tradition entails so chapters know what they are eligible for. Chapters are able to continue promoting these awards by applying for them and completing the Strive for Five goals.
- Keep a written and/or posted history of the district's events throughout the term.
 Numerous events take place within the Southwest District in the span of a year, including Convention(s), Leadership Conferences, and Area Workshops. I would plan to create posts for the social media pages that give an overview of the bonding and lessons from each event. I would also plan to keep a written record of events alongside pictures.
- Encourage chapters to collaborate with their campus libraries and/or band programs in order to archive or display KKPsi events and history so that it is better preserved. So much chapter history is easily lost because no one takes the time or knows of a way to preserve records of events. My goal is to change that so chapters know where they have come from to be the current version of their respective chapters.

Communication

It is vital for any member of Kappa Kappa Psi to be able to communicate effectively. A mere lack of communication can be the reason for a dispute amongst individuals, or even the reason an entire chapter goes inactive. I have seen firsthand how communication can strengthen organizations, both inside my own chapter and the Howard Payne band program as a whole. One of my goals as Member at Large would be to strengthen communication on all levels of this fraternity. This would include:

- Have seminars or posts encouraging and providing ideas for the basis of good communication between brothers from the same chapter. This would also be effective to have regarding communications with other chapters, Tau Beta Sigma (or the other music organizations some chapters may interact with), and even from district to district. To me, good communication involves a basis of proper preparation; one must prepare what they are going to say so that it can be effective. When communicating, it is important to be concise, clear, and provide all the information necessary. It is vital to be open to feedback and criticism and be able to work with other people to come to compromises.
- Encourage an improvement in communication between district officers and the chapters they are from and represent. It is important for brothers of the Southwest District to be informed and up-to-date on the occurrences of the district council that affect them.
- Building connections between chapters and individuals that can create lasting friendships or lead to great opportunities in the future through Kappa Kappa Psi. A connection could be made between chapters or individuals within chapters simply by meeting at district-wide events (like Conventions or workshops) or simply through social media platforms or the Southwest District Discord. I have been a part of starting a pen pal program with a few other chapters, which has been a great way to make connections with other students in different chapters; I would love to implement this district-wide. I have made many lifelong friends through this fraternity and built connections with alumni and band directors that could impact my future career, and I feel that everyone deserves the same positive experience in Kappa Kappa Psi that I have.
