4. Vice President for Leadership Development Report

- a. As per our last meeting (the notes from it I received), I have checked into the limit of players for the online games!
 - Gimkit (500 limit for live games, 60 for 2D game modes)
 - Kahoot (10 limit)
 - Virtual Escape Room (most are from 1-6 total, but some recommend 2-4)
 - Pictionary (online versions are around 60, but it can be played on zoom/discord video call)
 - Among Us (4-15 players)
 - Scavenger Hunt (no limit, each chapter is a team or mix everyone up)
 - Charades (unlimited, but 8 recommended to avoid lots of chaos)
 - Jackbox Game (varies slightly but typically 3-8 players)
- ii. Trying to host this in early fall semester
- b. Also started going back over my notes from my VPLD meeting with Lizzi and am planning to come up with a list of possible chapters that may be willing to host Area Workshops in the areas I was planning to have them in!
