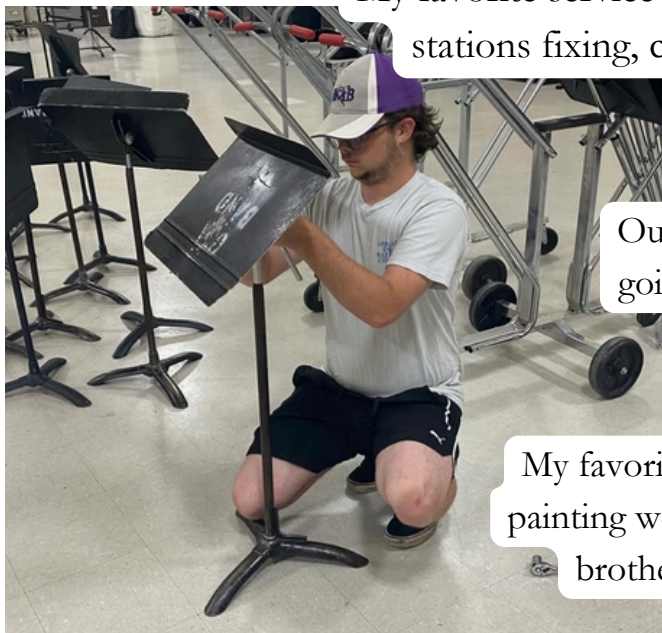

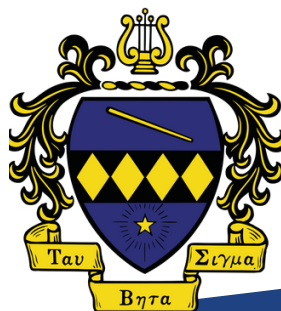

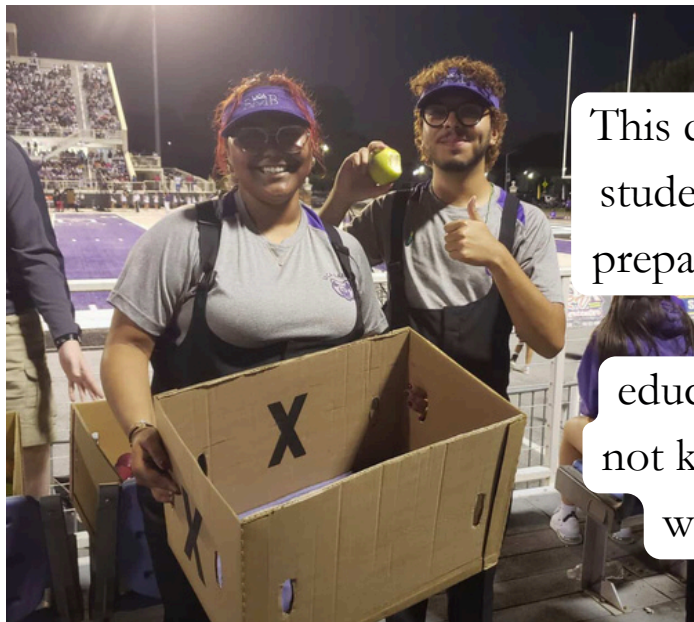

Douglas high school HBCU day:

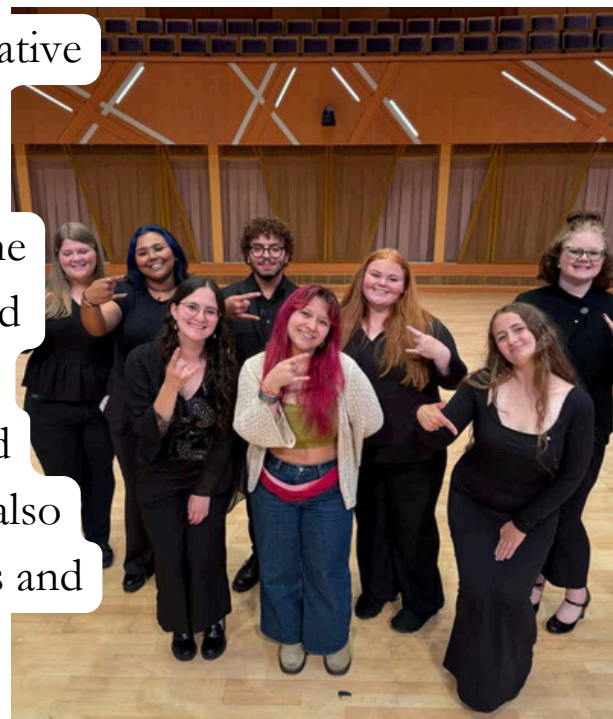
